

Joist & Girder Sizing Charts - Commercial

Tables below are for sizing TRIMAX structural joist and girder members in a typical deck situation. Please consult local building codes regarding design and required design Live Loads. Charts assume 90°F working temperature, 246,750 psi Adjusted MOE, and 3,380 psi Adjusted MOR. Blocking between joists must be installed when joists are spanning more than 6'-0". All Deck designs should be reviewed by a Professional Engineer.
